Thursday 3 rd	Meet at swimming pool entrance. Post & rail installation and dead hedge removal around pond. Woodland plant survey comps 10 and 6
Thursday 10 th	Bank holiday week
Thursday 17 th	Sid's bench installation. Wattle fence repair at Ruslands. Cherry laurel removal and clip paths in Newstead Wood and Meadow.
Thursday 24 th	Meet at Swimming Pool. Periwinkle removal and finish post & rail/netting. Wetland plant survey and dragonfly survey.
